

Charming Duck Pond

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Supplies:

- **Stamp Sets:** Charming Duck Pond (163344)
- **Card Stock and Paper:** Gray Granite (CS) (146983); Basic White CS (159276); Lily Pond Lane Designer Series Paper (DSP) (163342)
- **Stamp Pads:** Pretty Peacock Classic Ink (150083)
- **Tools:** Stylish Shapes Dies (159183)
- **Miscellaneous:** Adhesive-Backed Dappled Dots (163353); Peach Pie 3/8" Bordered Ribbon (163783); Stampin' Dimensionals (104430); Tear and Tape (154031); Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

- Gray Granite CS: 8 1/2" x 5 1/2"
- Basic White CS: 1" x 2" scrap (sentiment)
- Lily Pond Lane DSP:
 - Gray Granite dappled pattern: 4" x 5"
 - Peach Pie lily pattern: 3 3/4" x 4 1/2"
 - Gray Granite dragonfly pattern: 1 1/2" x 4 1/4"
 - Pretty Peacock dappled pattern: 3" x 3"
 - Pretty Peacock koi pattern: fussy cut 2 fish
- Peach Pie Ribbon: approximately 8"

Instructions:

1. Score Gray Granite CS on long side at 4 1/4", fold and burnish to create card base
2. Adhere Gray Granite dappled patterned DSP to left side of card front as shown
3. Adhere Peach Pie lily patterned DSP to left side of card front as shown
4. Wrap Peach Pie ribbon around Gray Granite dragonfly pattern DSP adhering ends to back side for DSP. Adhere to card front. Then use remaining ribbon to tie a knot on the front as shown
5. Die cut 2nd largest circle from Pretty Peacock dappled patterned DSP using Stylish Shapes dies and adhere over ribbon on card front using Stampin' Dimensionals
6. Fussy cut two koi fish from DSP and adhere to circle die cut



7. Stamp sentiment onto scrap of Basic White CS and cut out. I rounded the corners with my paper snips to maintain the flow of the circle and koi fish. Adhere, using Stampin' Dimensionals, to the circle focal layer
8. Add Flirty Flamingo Adhesive-Backed Dappled Dots to card front
