### About Home Truths 2

On its release in June 2020, the Home Truths report published by ACEVO and Voice4Change England had a central insight: civil society does not simply have a diversity problem; it has a racism problem. Landing shortly after the murder of George Floyd and an upsurge in the Black Lives Matter movement, Home Truths drew considerable attention.

But attention is not the same as action. Though some civil society leaders and organisations have taken positive steps forward, as a sector there is so much more to be done. For that reason, the Home Truths team has reassembled and has launched Home Truths 2.

Home Truths 2 is intended to accelerate ongoing work to make civil society a proactive force against racism and for race equity. It will also want to open up an even more visionary future in which the sector helps to re-imagine and co-create a world beyond racism, ableism, misogyny, in favour of justice and life-affirming possibilities for all.
