The student services team at ASCA is committed to helping all students learn and succeed in their education. The student services team at All Saints provides academic learning assistance to all students with in-class support, students who meet the criteria for intervention with small groups, one to one support outside of the classroom, and students who meet the criteria for enrichment class and junior high study skills support.

The Student Services department is composed of the Student Services Coordinator (Mrs. Aloisio), the resource teachers (Mrs. Carden and Mrs. Kujawa) and the school social worker (Mrs. Magana).

The Role of the Student Services Coordinator

- Special Education Compliance (advocating for students and families, ensuring student records and services are in accordance with state and federal law, gathering documentation for referrals, screens, IEP annual reviews, and outside evaluations)
- Related Services/ Intervention Services (collaborating with student services team, identifying academically at risk students and referring for outside supports and evaluations as needed, overseeing intervention and enrichment programs, monitoring overall student academic progress)
- Standardized Testing (manage all standardized tests, including testing software, student accommodations, teacher training, and data analysis)
- Collaborate with school administration to ensure students' needs are being met to the best of our ability
