INTRODUCTION

A flexible layout isn't all that flexible if some of the component parts are fixed. Text easily reflows as it's container resizes, but images and other media need to have percentages applied to their widths using CSS.

DIRECTIONS

1. Duplicate the folder named "fluidGrid_lastname" and rename it "flexibleMedia_lastname".
2. Download the media files for this assignment and place them in a folder called images in the "flexibleMedia_lastname" folder.
3. Open the page called "index.html" and change the title the page to "Flexible Media".
4. Remove the following CSS from the head section.

5. Insert the media into the div tag with the matching name.
6. Use CSS Styles to make the media flexible as the window size changes.
7. Add your name to the page.
