ACCESS Virtual Learning (Alabama Connecting Classrooms, Educators, and Students Statewide) is an education initiative of the Alabama Department of Education. It provides opportunities and options for Alabama public high school students to engage in Advanced Placement (AP), core, elective, and other courses to which they may not otherwise have access or be able to schedule.

- Courses are interactive, engaging and rigorous.

- Materials/Resources are embedded in course content for the majority of courses.
- No limits are placed on the number of courses a student may take.
- All courses are taught by an Alabama Certified teacher.

- Credit Recovery courses (not NCAA approved)
