- 1.4. wheel/pedal combo (no controllers)

7:00pm – GATES OPEN FOR PRACTICE

8:00pm – 3 LAP CLOSED QUALIFYING

8:10pm - DRIVERS MEETING, STARTING GRID, AND SHORT PACE LAP

3. RACE FORMAT

- 3.1. Everyone will be driving the Toyota GR86 at Road Atlanta
- 3.2. Open setups, fuel will be capped at 66% capacity
- 3.3. Time of day in game will be synced to real world time
- 3.4. This race will be 2 hours long, solo driven
- 3.5. This is a charity race, the goal of which is to have fun and raise money for a great cause NMDP (Formerly be the match)
- 3.6. There is a \$10 entry fee per car entered into the race, 100% of all funds raised go to the NMDP. Pay your entry fee here

4. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 4.1. While this is a charity race, iracing sporting code still applies in regards to driving standards so intentional contact or other unsportsmanlike behavior will not be tolerated. Excessive abuse will result in a swift and merciless DQ.
- 4.2. Damage will be turned on, however fast repairs will not be limited
- 4.3. Race Control is God during the race, anything they say must be obeyed and there is no formal review or protest system. All complaints about race control during the race will be ignored.

- 4.4. Included in a teams \$10 entry fee is the ability to give one drive through penalty and one stop and hold penalty (described below). There are no limits on the total of donations you may make however, the price for each additional penalty is as follows:
 - 4.4.1. Drivers may pledge to donate \$1 to have race control give another driver a drive through penalty
 - 4.4.2. Drivers may pledge \$3 to issue a stop and go penalty to another driver, as in you will pull into your pit stall and iracing will hold your car there for 30s, after which maintenance(fuel, tires, any repairs) may begin or you may resume racing.
 - 4.4.3. Drivers may pledge \$5 to issue a one lap stop and go penalty to another driver
 - 4.4.4. If a Driver has been given a slow down penalty by iRacing, he or she can donate \$1 to have it removed.
 - 4.4.5. If a Driver has been issued a penalty, he or she has the opportunity to donate double the penalty fee to have it negated.
 - 4.4.6. Race Control may deny a penalty if they feel a team or driver is being targeted too much, we want people to actually be racing not just sitting in the pits
 - 4.4.7. Pledges may be made via text message DM in iracing or over voice chat(if you choose voice chat it is not race controls responsibility to remember, you may have to remind them if they miss it)
 - 4.4.8. Race control is free to adjust the pricing of these perks as they see fit during the race
 - 4.4.9. No penalties will be applied in the first or last 10 minutes of the race
- 4.5. You are required to have iracing voice chat turned on to hear the driver meetings during gridding before the race, you may turn it off if you wish after that.
- 4.6. Upon request, teams may have a dedicated voice chat for their team in the MA86 iracing discord server. Otherwise teams are responsible for their own communication mechanism
