Please read the following Participation Agreement. All participants auditioning for roles must submit this signed agreement on the day of their audition. Participants will not be considered for roles unless this agreement is received by the director on the day of your audition.

- 1. I will attend all rehearsals for which I am called, unless excused by the director.
- 2. If I am unable to attend a rehearsal, I will <u>personally notify the director</u> by <u>e-mail, phone, or note</u> PRIOR to the beginning of the rehearsal.
- 3. I understand that absence from three rehearsals (excused or unexcused) beyond those listed as my blackout dates will jeopardize my continued participation in this production and may result in my part being recast.
- 4. I will arrive to each rehearsal on time and stay for the entire rehearsal. In the event that I must arrive late or leave early, I will <u>personally notify the director</u> by e-mail, phone, or note PRIOR to the beginning of the rehearsal.
- 5. I will not miss any rehearsals during the last two weeks of the production (June 9-22).
- 6. I will remember that holding a role as a member of the cast or crew is considered a leadership position and will conduct myself in a professional and respectful manner at all times. I understand that if my behavior is disruptive, or a poor representation of our production or the organization as a whole, I may be asked to leave rehearsal or the production, depending on the severity.
- 7. I will responsibly manage my time commitments, including school work and other commitments, so that I can participate in this production.
- 8. I will be prepared for each rehearsal with a pencil, my script, a full water bottle, and a positive attitude.
- 9. I understand that it is imperative for members of the cast/crew to work well together; therefore, I will be respectful of others in the cast/crew and will immediately alert the director to any problems that may disrupt the ensemble.
- 10. I will turn off / silence / put away my cell phone during rehearsal. I will refrain from using my cell phone during rehearsal in order to remain focused and attentive.
- 11. I will accept the leadership of the Production/Directing team, including that of any appointed Stage Management participants and abide by their directions without argument or attitude.
- 12. I will have my lines and blocking completely memorized and be able to go confidently off book on or before the date indicted on the production calendar.
- 13. I will not cut or dye my hair or otherwise alter my appearance between auditions and showtime without consulting with the director.
