HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR AD

STEP 1: GO ONLINE


- Go to www.YearbookOrderCenter.com
- Type in the school code : **3610**
- View the "Create an Ad" video
- Click on "Create and Ad" to set up a site
- Call toll free 877.362.7750 for tech help

STEP 2: CREATE IT!

You can work on your ad in multiple sessions so that you can take your time to make sure your student's ad is perfect!

STEP 3: PAY & SUBMIT!

Once you're finished, pay for your ad online. You will receive a proof with your receipt.

2. If you ordered pictures for your underclass student, they are available for pick-up in the main office. Pick up Monday - Friday between 8:00am - 3:00 pm.
3. Just a reminder that we are nearing Fall Break. Our Fall Break dates are Monday, November 2nd and Tuesday, November 3rd (election day). While this is later than normal this school year, we wanted to take a moment to remind you that it is coming quickly. Also, please be reminded that Daylight Savings ends this Sunday - set your clocks back 1 hour Saturday night.
4. Immediately following Fall Break, select seniors will be practicing and participating in the ISTEP+ graduation qualifying exam. Only those who have not already passed both sections of the ISTEP+ or achieved a passing score on the ASVAB will be invited to take this assessment. Practice test dates will be on Thursday, November 5th or Friday, November 6th. Senior students will be notified which day and time they will need to participate with the practice test.

The ISTEP+ test window opens on Monday, November 9th and we will begin testing on that day. Students will be notified individually what day, time, and location for the test(s) they have to take. We hope to have this information emailed to you and your student tomorrow.

Remember, this is a state mandated test and one of the requirements for graduation, it is imperative that students make their best effort to take and pass the test at each available opportunity.
