

EduJunior Online Poster-Making Competition Guidelines

Eligibility:

- The contest is open to students enrolled in Kindergarten through Grade 12.
- Participants must obtain prior permission from their parents, legal guardians, or teachers to enter the competition.

Poster Specification

- Each participant may submit only one poster.
- Posters must be made on A3 size (11.7 * 16.5 inches) sheets with margins (0.5 inches) drawn in black pen/marker.
- Only original, hand-made posters will be accepted.
- The theme of the poster should be clearly mentioned at the top margin.
- Content should be original and should not violate any religious, linguistic, or social sentiments.
- Upper-class students (Grades 7–12) must ensure that the poster is interactive, creative, and carries a moral or meaning. The moral should be written clearly at the base of the poster.

Submission Requirements

- Participants must upload a clear picture of their poster in JPG/PNG format, with a file size not exceeding 2 MB.
- Along with the poster picture, participants must submit a picture of themselves holding the poster in landscape format.
- Participants must also provide any valid ID proof (School ID Is Sufficient)
- All entries must include the entrant's first name, grade/class, and school name.

Entry Fee And Registration

- There is an entry fee of **INR 349**, payable upon registration.
- To register and submit your entry, please fill out the online registration form provided and proceed with the payment.

Evaluation Criteria

- Entries will be judged based on relevance to the theme, originality, creativity, artistic composition, and the message conveyed.
- The Judges' evaluation will determine the final outcome for each participant.

Application Process

Step 1: Registration

- Fill out the registration form.
- Ensure all details are filled accurately.
- Make the payment as required.
- Receive the payment receipt over the mentioned email.
- Note that registration will be closed on **October 20th, 2025**.

Step 2: Poster Submission

- Read the rules and guidelines of the contest.
- Select one theme from the two given options.
- Submit the poster on or before the submission date, which is **October 25th, 2025**.

Step 3: Announcement and Awards

- Wait for the announcement period where winners and runner-ups will be declared.
- Certificates and awards will be awarded to the winners and runner-ups.

Themes and Age Categories

Kindergarten (Below Grade 1)

Theme: My Happy Garden

- Draw a colorful garden with flowers, butterflies, and a bright sun.
- Paint yourself watering plants or playing among flowers.

Theme: A Rainbow in My City

- Draw a rainbow shining over buildings and trees.
- Paint happy people enjoying the rainbow in a park or street.

Note: You can choose **one** of these themes for poster-making.

Grades 1–3

Theme: Bye-Bye Plastic!

- Draw people using cloth or paper bags instead of plastic.
- Paint sea animals and birds happy in a clean environment.

Theme: Switch Off Lights, Switch On the Stars

- Illustrate a city at night with lights turned off and stars twinkling.
- Paint children watching the night sky full of stars and the moon.

Note: You can choose **one** of these themes for poster-making.

Grades 4–6 (Use bright colors and simple words so anyone can understand your poster's message at a glance.)

Theme: My One Action to Save Earth

- Draw yourself planting trees, saving water, or recycling.
- Paint Earth smiling because of your good action.

Theme: Say NO to Junk Food

- Illustrate healthy food like fruits, vegetables, and milk in bright colors.
- Paint junk food being replaced with healthy meals on a plate.

Note: You can choose **one** of these themes for poster-making.

Grades 7–9 (Add a short, catchy slogan to your poster that clearly shares your message and grabs attention.)

Theme: The World I Want in 2050

- Draw a clean, green, and happy world with flying cars and green parks.
- Paint children enjoying nature with your slogan on the top.

Theme: Our Future Without Pollution

- Illustrate clear skies, clean rivers, and healthy wildlife.
- Paint factories with no smoke and add your powerful slogan.

Note: You can choose **one** of these themes for poster-making.

Grades 10–12 (Write a short, powerful moral at the base of your poster that connects to your theme, inspires change, and leaves a strong impact.)

Theme: Smart Energy Choices for Tomorrow

- Draw solar panels, windmills, and people saving electricity.
- Paint a bright future powered by clean energy with your moral at the bottom.

Theme: Disconnect to Reconnect – Life Beyond the Screen

- Illustrate people enjoying nature, sports, and spending time with family.
- Paint a happy outdoor scene with your moral written clearly at the base.

Note: You can choose **one** of these themes for poster-making.

Prizes and Honors

- **Top Winner in Each Category:**
 - a. Trophy
 - b. Gold Medal
 - c. Paint Colours
 - d. Hard Copy of Certificate
- **Runners-Up:**
 - a. Gold Medal
 - b. Water Bottle
 - c. Hard Copy of Certificate
- **Outstanding Performances in Each Category:**
 - a. Silver Medal
 - b. Pen/Pencil
 - c. Hard Copy of Certificate
- **All Participants:**
 - a. Offline Certificate of Participation
- **Teacher in Charge:**
 - a. Appreciation Certificate
