The Student CARE Closet

The Student CARE Closet is equipped with basic resources for students. It is regularly stocked with clothing, food items, personal hygiene items, and assorted school supplies. Additional items such as coats, hats gloves, socks, etc. are provided as needed.



Vision CARE Program

NCCP provides eye examinations and glasses for eligible students who have failed previous eye exams. Some restrictions apply. This service is available in partnership with Target Optical



The Family CARE Closet is our school-based food pantry The Family CARE closes is our school-based roop pantry located inside the high school. Families with students enrolled in CUSD187 are invited to visit the FCC twice a month. Ongoing resources available include shelf-stable food items, household essentials, and hygiene supplies. Additionally, referral resources are available for local community-support

The Family CARE Closet is open on Thursdays when school is in session from 8:00-11:00 AM and from 1:00-4:00 PM.
