



Nominations are now being accepted for the

Best Book in Public Budgeting & Finance Award

Nominations due June 20, 2026

The Association for Budgeting & Financial Management solicits nominations for the Best Book Award. The Best Book Award shall be awarded to the best submission for an outstanding public budgeting and finance book or edited volume published within the past three years (**2023** or more recently). Award eligibility is limited to books with association members in good standing. The book should be targeted to an academic research audience, and not be a textbook or a practitioner workbook. Preference will be given to books rather than edited volumes. Nominations (including self) should include a brief letter of introduction highlighting the scholarly contribution of the book for the ABFM audience.

The nominations are due to **Justin Ross** (justross@iu.edu) by **June 20, 2026**. Nominations from previous years satisfying the eligibility criteria are automatically considered for the 2026 award. Physical or electronic copies will be requested for individual members of the Award committee to assist in evaluation.
