Is it time for a checkup? Stay ahead of the bad guys with this quick and easy list of cybersecurity checks for your Wake Forest account, custom-built by IS.

	For the most secure WFU mail experience, use native Google Mail apps ,
	which include helpful security features and external sender alerts to keep
	your accounts safe. Other mail apps (such as Apple Mail and Outlook) lack
	these alerts and features, leaving you more vulnerable to hacking or phishing
	ploys.
	☐ On your laptop, use <u>mail.google.com</u> to view and manage your WFU mail
	account. Easily separate work and personal accounts using Chrome profiles.
	On Android, use the Google Mail app from Google Play.
	On iOS, use Google's Mail app, from the Apple App Store.
	Run a Google Security Checkup from your @wfu.edu and personal Gmail profiles
	Set up an easy, secure biometric passkey as one of your Google 2-step options
	Set up an auto-lock for your laptop after a period of inactivity
	Take your annual cybersecurity training or revisit any time you would like a refresher.
