How to have FFD pay for a Vehicle Inspection/Repair

- Make an appointment with a State of Maine Vehicle Inspection Garage
- Get a complete, itemized written estimate. This must have all estimated costs, including the cost of an inspection sticker, to make your car pass inspection.
- Give the estimate to your FFD Coach
- Your FFD Coach will submit a request for your vehicle to be repaired/inspected
- Your FFD Coach will let you know if it was approved or denied.
- If it is approved, make an appointment with the garage for repairs to be completed.
- Payment will be made directly from FFD to the Garage.

Important things to know BEFORE you request funding:

- Your Coach will need a copy of your valid Driver's License
- Your Coach will need a copy of your valid vehicle registration
- Your Coach will need a copy of your valid insurance card
- You will need to make more than one trip to the garage
- FFD reserves the right to request a second estimate, if the costs seem extensive
- Any repairs are for the purpose of making your vehicle pass a Maine State Inspection. Some repairs cannot be funded (for example air conditioning, sound systems, etc.)
- FFD does not guarantee all funding requests will be approved
