

## Instrumental Music Tuition (from September 2025) Senior School

At Kent College, all pupils are encouraged to take an active role in music and we offer a broad range of opportunities for pupils of every age and ability. Instrumental tuition is available on all standard orchestral and band instruments, singing, piano and guitar. It will normally be possible to receive a free trial lesson to confirm suitability for a particular instrument.

Lessons are taught individually, and for the academic year 2025-26 will be charged at £220/term for 10 x 30 minute lessons. During the course of the year, pupils receive thirty lessons. The teachers work on a self-employed basis and will send an invoice directly to parents at the start of each term. Lessons take place during the school day and will normally operate on a rotational system in years 7 - 9 to ensure pupils do not miss the same academic lesson from week to week. For Year 10, 11, 12 and 13, lessons will be arranged outside of academic lessons. This system is closely monitored and timetables are clearly displayed on line each week and on the parent portal and pupils' 'Google Classroom'.

Whilst individual practice and participation in ensembles is essential to both the enjoyment of music and musical development, this initially springs from inspirational teaching. I am therefore delighted that we have such an excellent team of highly experienced and professional instrumental tutors at Kent College.

The following two points are conditional of tuition being arranged for pupils:

- 1) Should you wish to cancel music lessons at any point, written notice must be given by the end of half term directly to the music teacher (copying in the Director of Music) to terminate lessons from the start of the following full term.
- 2) If a pupil has arranged to attend a lesson and doesn't turn up, the missed lesson will be charged for.

## Instrumental Music Tuition Senior School Instrumental Music Tuition Teachers' Terms and Conditions

The full Terms and Conditions under which music lessons are provided are as follows:

- The instrumental teacher will use his/her best endeavours to schedule 30 lessons for each pupil over the course of an academic year (from September to the following July).
- No more than 10 lessons will be invoiced in respect of any one term except by prior agreement between the parent/guardian and teacher. Where more than 10 lessons are actually taught in a term (e.g. during the long Autumn term) the surplus lessons will be carried over and invoiced in the subsequent term(s).
- Payment of the invoice is due in advance of the commencement of the term to which it relates.
- Lessons will still be charged if the pupil is absent for any reasons.
- Any lesson(s) charged for but not actually taught by the teacher during the relevant term due to the teacher's absence will be credited on the following term's invoice.
- Any music, reeds or other sundries supplied by the teacher to the pupil during the course of a term will be invoiced in arrears on the following term's account.
- Notice to discontinue tuition on an instrument must be in writing and received by the teacher
  by the end of the half-term holiday in the term preceding that in which the lessons are to
  be discontinued, except that in respect of the lessons in the Autumn term notice must be
  given no later than the end of the preceding Summer term, failing which a term's fees will
  be payable in lieu of notice.
- Parents/guardians will be notified during the summer term of the rate of tuition fees chargeable for lessons during the academic year starting the following September.
- All instrumental lessons will take place at Kent College except where alternative arrangements are agreed between the teacher and the parent/guardian with the approval of the Director of Music of Kent College.
- The instrumental teacher may appoint a deputy teacher approved by Kent College to undertake the teaching of any or all of the lessons covered by this invoice.
- All lessons will normally be taught in person, on site, during school hours unless there is
  ever a need for the school to close during term time. If for any other reason, an in person
  lesson in school is not possible, an online lesson may be offered at the discretion of, and
  mutual arrangement with the teacher.
