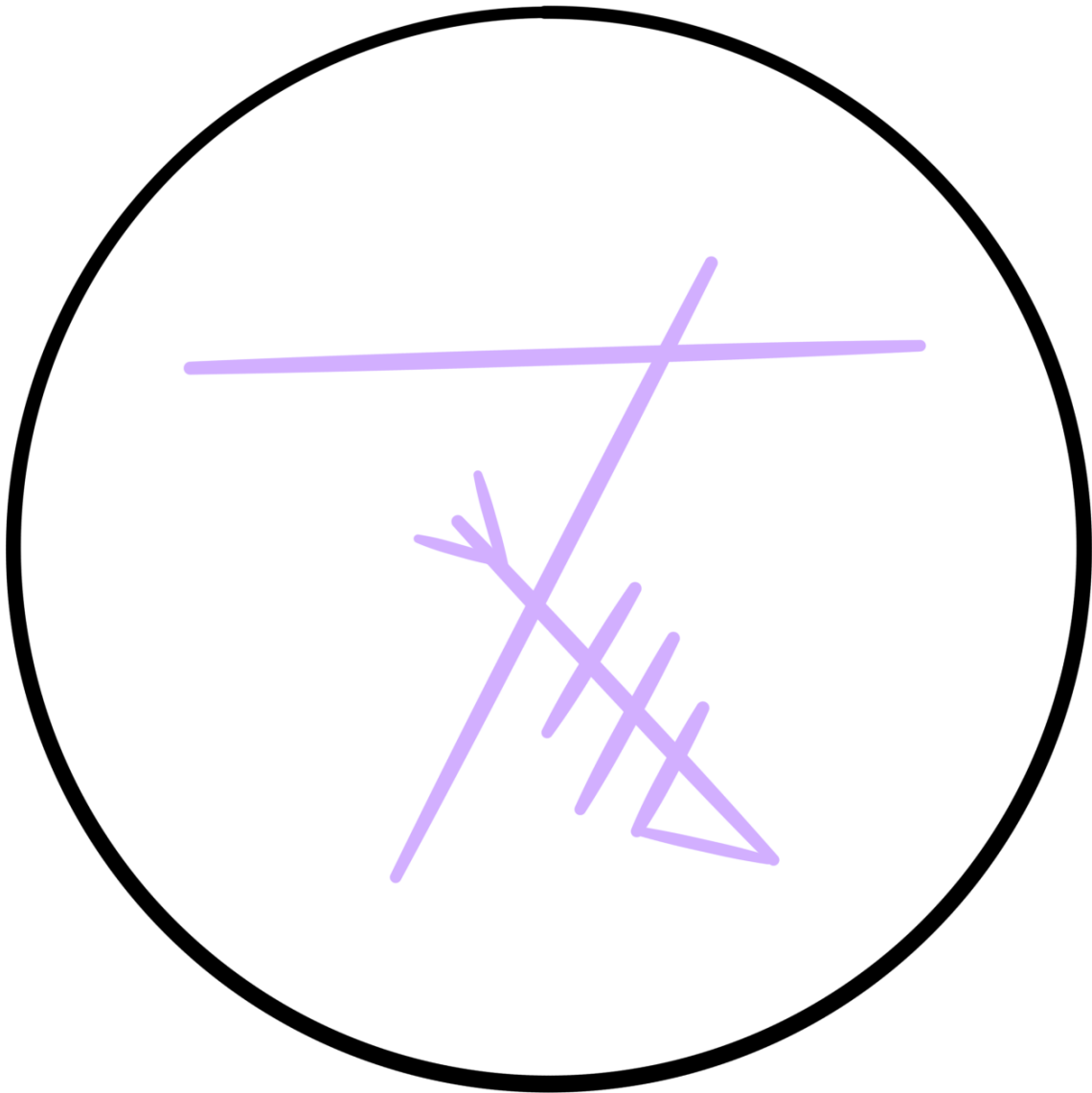


Amok symbol.

Symbolization and their meaning.

Amok:



The mark is probably one of the more commonly used in both civilian and military life, this mark makes objects reconfigure them self after being broken.

Now this symbol has been probably used on many soldiers rifles or on kitchen utensils by the mrs/mr back at home waiting for the spouse to return or just at a family dinner.

Properties!

Objects:

like explained beforehand, it gives an object to the capability of either reconfiguring itself or generating more material seemingly out of nowhere. Depending on the damage, it will either reconfigure, or just generate new material.

As long as the mark isn't scratched off then you're gun pretty much doesn't need a replacing of parts, it still will need to be maintained due to dirt and grime not registering as damage.

Human subject:

This has been done throughout history but many would rather not do this as they would see it as nothing but a curse, a removable curse but a curse nonetheless.

If left undisturbed for an incredible amount of time, the person can live for 150-160 years, but of course this has saved many lives but many people would rather die then have this on their person. Side effects!

Example: "I wanna saw off my shotgun!" As you go to saw off your shotgun, the barrel simply reattached itself onto the gun again. "Awww..."

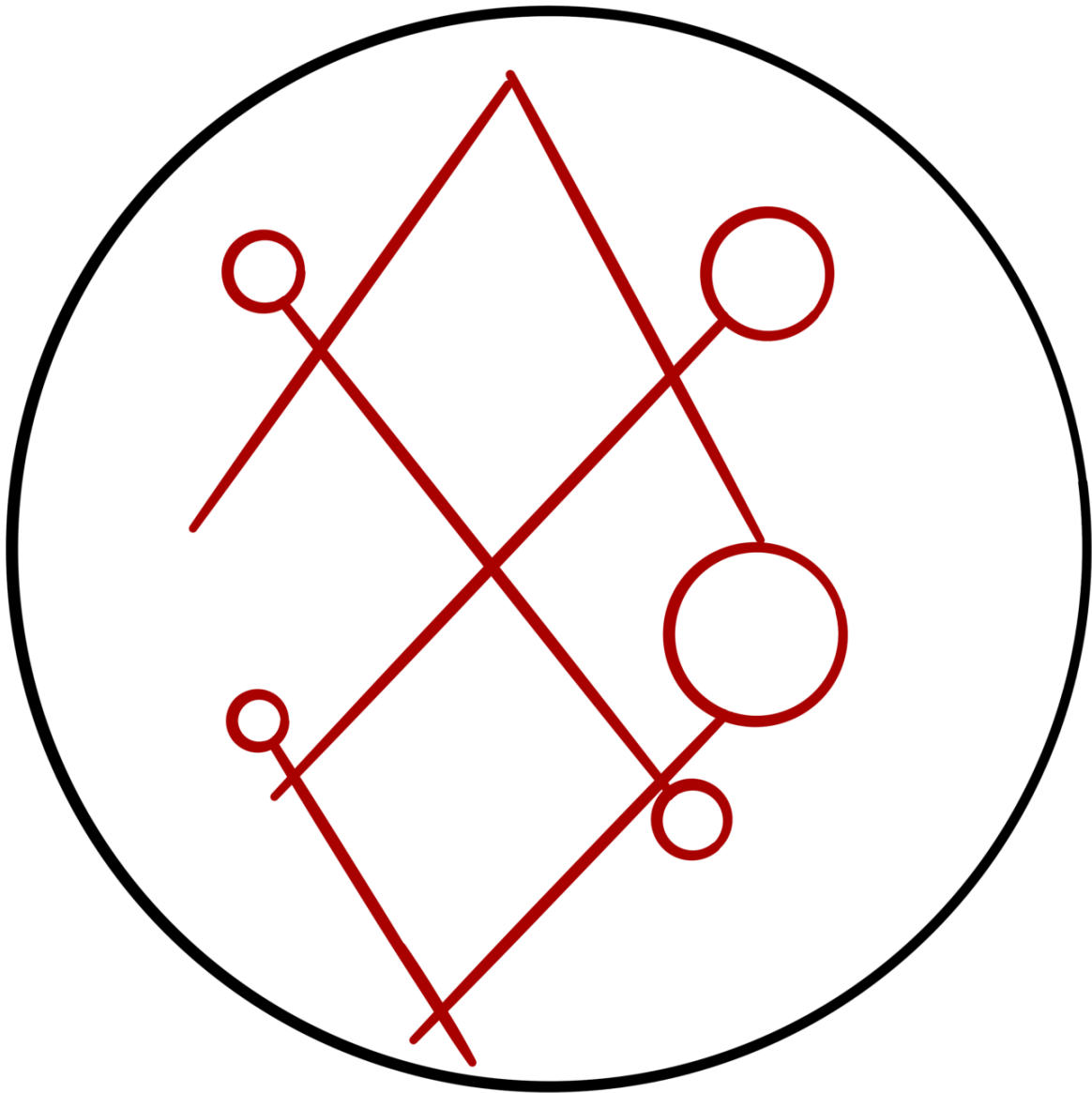
