Synopsis:

Characters:

Girl: Shy, socially anxious, with a notable scar on her face.

Boy: Outgoing and happy-go-lucky.

Script:

Page 1:

L1 Panel 1:	Girl sitting at her desk in a classroom, clearly a bit nervous. Some vague silhouettes around.
L2 Panel 2:	Looking even more uneasy, she hesitantly reaches her hand up towards the scar on her face. The background distorts, as Shadowy figures stretch up around her, looking as if they are whispering and laughing about her [and her scar].
L3 Panel 3:	Boy glances over to his side, noticing something.
Boy: 	Hm?
L3 Panel 4:	Foreground: [Boy's] Hand waves at Girl. Background: Girl glances up, momentarily distracted.
Boy:	Hey!
L4 Panel 5:	Left side Midground: Boy starts taking his shirt off in the middle of the class. Right Side Foreground — Headshot: Girl beginning to look embarrassed.

Page 2:

L1 Panel 1:	Girl with hands pseudo covering eyes/face.
L1 Panel 2:	Same Shot: Girl embarrassed and peeking through her hands.
L2 Panel 3:	Boy with a big smile pointing at the scar across his chest [similar looking to hers].
Boy:	We match!
L3 Panel 4:	Headshot: Girl not fully knowing what to make of the display, but seemingly somewhat put at ease by it.
L3 Panel 5:	Headshot: Girl looking away bashfully.
L4 Panel 6:	Fade out panel. [Bubbles with Cut Ins]
Girl:	p-Please put your shirt back on.
Boy:	Haha! Sure, sure.
