[MantisX](#), a revolutionary shooting analysis system that helps shooters of all types to improve their shooting skills. Connect MantisX to the accessory rail of any firearm, just like you would any other firearm attachment. Works with live fire, dry fire, airsoft, and CO2 to evaluate shooting performance, identify areas of improvement, and track progress over time. Install the smartphone application and your read to go.

The Mantis device tracks the movement of your handgun's barrel during the trigger pull and will track the score of each shot individually. Shots are grouped according to movement pattern.

The **Detailed Trace** feature shows the movement of your shot just before the trigger pull, the trigger pull and the shot break and recoil pattern.

The smartphone app tracks your progress and allows the forming of groups. Join my group "Raritan Valley Pistol League" and we will track our progress together.

Are you Registered to Vote?

The Election on November 3rd will be for the reelection of [President Trump](#) and to replace Senator Cory Booker. If you are not registered to vote, you must do so by Tuesday October 13th for the General Election. We have several links on our website, under "Membership" to help you register.

We need every 2nd Amendment friendly voter to vote, no excuses accepted.

Register to Vote: In NJ you must register to vote prior to the General Election, we do not have same day registration. To vote in the primary election where we pick the candidates to run for office, you must declare your party affiliation, Democrat or Republican. NJ does not have primary elections for declared independent candidates. **We have several links on our website, under "Membership" to help you register.**

Vote by Mail: If you prefer voting by mail vs physically going to your local voting booth, you have that right. You must request a mail in ballot from your County Clerk by Tuesday Oct 27th. and return it by mail or in person to the Clerk's Office by November 3rd. **Our website, under "Membership", has a link with all the information regarding voting by mail.**

No Excuses Accepted: We can't express enough how important it is for all eligible members to vote for 2nd. Amendment friendly candidates. This newsletter has links for four Republican candidates for US Senate, all of whom are 2nd Amendment supporters. We also link President Trump, Joe Biden and Cory Booker.
