SUBJECT: 22-23 CAPR 26: Discontinue offering the Bachelor of Arts Sociology at the Concord Campus

PURPOSE: For action by the Academic Senate

ACTION REQUESTED: That the Academic Senate approve removing the Bachelor of Arts Sociology at the Concord Campus and send their approval to President Sandeen for authorization. Once President Sandeen authorizes, Dean Scharberg, as our WSCUC Accreditation Liaison Officer, will remove this program from our WSCUC program page for this location.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

In preparation for our WSCUC 2025 reaffirmation of our accreditation, the campus is reviewing our programs at our published locations as noted by WSCUC. Article II.B.3 of [CAPR Policies and Procedures \(19-20 CAPR 24\)](#) states that CAPR can provide recommendations to the Academic Senate on the use of campus facilities. Dr. Luz Calvo, Interim Associate Dean of CLASS, and Dr. Linda Dobb, Chair of Sociology, have confirmed that this degree is not offered at the Concord Campus. Students who have recently completed courses for the Bachelor of Arts Sociology at the Concord Campus will be advised to complete coursework on-line or at the Hayward Campus.
