

Writing Introductions



More details regarding triangle set-up from above:

- engage the reader: create a very vivid/sensory description of what your world is like → images, narrative action (almost as if you're writing the beginning of a story)
- 2. **background info**: transition to expository/persuasive writing →
 - -example: This picture is not from the latest movie; it is the future we are building if we continue to...
 - -example: This future is closer than we might want to believe if our society continues to...
 - -example: This glimpse of the future can only come true if our society realizes that...
- 3. **claim**: the strong, focused point, which is very opinionated, very complex, and very specific, that organizes your essay

Writing conclusions

- 1. Restate claim
- 2. Explain why the issue is important
- 3. Call to action
