- Read John 8:12; John 9:5. Who is identified as the Light of the World in these passages?
- Why does the passage in Matthew 6 identify Christians as the light of the world; but, the passage in John says it is Jesus?
- In what ways do you think we are tempted to place our light under a basket?

We Shine Bright When We Serve the City

- What is the best way to let your light shine for Christ unto others?
- Read Colossians 3:23-24. What does Paul mean when he says to “work heartily”?
- What is the inheritance we are expecting to receive from the Lord?
- Read Philippians 2:14-15. Why do you think Paul is imploring the readers and the people he is teaching to do things without grumbling?
- What is the connection between doing things without grumbling and being the light of the world?
- What are some ways we can get caught up with grumbling in our daily life?

2. In which ways can we serve the people around us, either inside or outside of our church building?
