Essential Question: How do we overcome adversity?

Task:

As you read, keep track of passages that give insight to your character and the essential question. Focus on what the main character *says* and *does*.

Step One: Inquiry Questions

Choose <u>three</u> of the following questions to answer about your book for <u>each</u> reading assignment. Paste the question into the left-hand column. You will have <u>six questions total</u> for your book.

- What motivates the main character?
- How do we learn about the main character through his/her thoughts, actions, and dialogue?
- What problems does the main character face?
- How does the author build suspense?
- How is the main character feeling?
- How does the main character interact with other characters in the story?
- How does the main character handle hardship?
- Which passages give you clues to what might happen next?
- How does the main character grow or change?

Step Two: Find a passage that answers your question

Step 3: Analysis/Response

Respond to each passage on the right-hand side of the table. Explain how the passage answers your question. You will need to read in between the lines of what the text actually says and explain what it implies. This means you will be **making inferences** and explaining them by discussing each passage in depth.
