- Last year we had images of poor quality that could not be printed and did not show well on the web site. Get in close to the artwork, fill the frame of your camera or cell phone.
- Try not to zoom in, can pixelate. Before you submit, crop and straighten. We should only see the image, no other background noise.
- **Pay careful attention to your submissions and make sure that the images are clean: good lighting, not blurry, can be enlarged without being pixelated and do not show ribbons**
