- Work based on a "published" photo, other artists' work, copyrighted images, or considered inappropriate for K-12 public school venues, <u>WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.</u>

You have already registered since last school year. Go to ArtfulEvaluation.com and sign in and begin entering your student's artwork.

- 3. <u>Select/Prepare Artwork</u> (4 student artwork, per art teacher, as per guidelines)

- Last year we had images of poor quality that could not be printed and did not show well on the web site.

 Get in close to the artwork, fill the frame of your camera or cell phone.
- Try not to zoom in, can pixelate. Before you submit, crop and straighten. We should only see the image, no other background noise.
- Pay careful attention to your submissions and make sure that the images are clean: good lighting, not blurry, can be enlarged without being pixelated and do not show ribbons

4. April 04, 2025. Upload artwork and artist statement to ArtfulEvaluation.com

Upload the artist statement with your entry. 2-4 sentences, no more, <u>please</u>. This really helped the judges determine winners by knowing more about the artist's intent.

5. Print the Release form and get parent signatures.



6. **Track the Release Form**: Once you have the returned/ signed release form (it is up to the teacher to track the release forms) Go Back onto the website and enter the release form number by the bar code, then click on the "Track Release Form" button and enter the number. The name of your student will appear, and it will confirm that the form is tracked.



IMPORTANT!! Deadline is a Deadline.
