Tarone Jorvannan Lore

Up until the age of five, Tarone lived a rather uneventful life. He was the second youngest of five other siblings: his four older siblings being Rozerra, Saudon, Corellia, and Munox and his younger sibling being Kadren. His family lived rather far from any city, in a smaller civilization with few people, where everyone was mostly self-sufficient. Most people, also, disregarded religion or any sort of deity, and many of the children grew up without it. But when Tarone was five, the town was raided by a group of barbarians who only did so to gather not only what the village had but also the people in it - to use them as servants and train the fit to fight for them and their cause (their cause being - kill anyone and everyone who is rich and selfish).

Naturally, many of the children were taught to fight by them and some of them were given certain abilities to enhance their strength or their resilience - especially the younger kids, like Tarone, who was given a mutation (which included a hell of a lot of pain - very Deadpool-esque) in order to enhance his resilience and stamina.

The whole organisation was very underground and unknown so it was hidden away from a lot of culture, so, again, there was a lot of missed information for people down there. The children got an education, but it wasn't nearly made to be as important as fighting. Even the kids who would be put to work because they weren't good enough to fight weren't given any education higher than moderate - however, a lot of the children ended up being rather smart from figuring out things themselves.

Everyone in this organisation became used to the conditions they lived in, but a lot of the children who grew up fighting would be thrown into fights against each other. Some people would die and it was just normal. However, this made a lot of people hostile towards each other, whether it be vengeful, ranking (which was made into a big deal who was better than who), general hatred, or simply out of spite. Not to mention that the barbarians who ran the place would use chemical elements on many of the fighters to make them more dangerous without mutating them - which left a lot of families too to turn against each other - notably Tarone and his oldest sibling and sister, Rozerra. The two were never forced to fight because of their age difference at the time (7 years), but it was as early as when Tarone was 12 and Rozerra was 19 that the two turned against each other, often getting into fights for no conceivable reason (chemicals). Whenever they did fight, no one would really do much about it except their parents (who didn't fight, as they were older). However, through these fights, it was proven that Tarone especially was very powerful for his age because he didn't seem to have troubles beating a 19 y/o.

Tarone was 15 when the organisation was finally discovered by authorities from one of the main cities in the country and was abolished by them. However, so many of the younger people or those who grew up fighting down there were close to mentally insane from all the mutations and chemical works done on them. They were taken to the city and put in a hospital, but a lot of people died on the way and in the process of trying to heal them, solely because a few barely had any real blood left in them.

It was impossible to fully heal everyone, but Tarone along with many others got let out mostly healed from the chemicals and such, but the mutations couldn't be taken away. Despite the fact that the hostility chemical was mostly gone, Rozerra and Tarone still were at each other's throats when they got released at

17 and 24. It's not certain why, but it has never gone away and the two are more prone to fight over everyday issues with each other.

Many of the people were not put into a fighting class solely because the city authorities wanted them to have a life that was more than just fighting, but likewise, many of the people still did it anyway because it was so natural to them - including Tarone, Rozerra, and Kadren. The three of them along with others in the initial fighting class didn't need to stay there as long because they were already so advanced fighting-wise - they were instead transferred to what was allowed and what was not. Also being fair in the arena. This didn't change the competitiveness in many of them nor the need to be better than everyone else. Many of them also were stuck in the mind set that those who were rich were just bad and selfish people and they should be killed for that - though anyone who acted upon that were arrested, of course.

The people from the organisation were often revolted against by people who thought they were too dangerous to be alive in the city and such, and a lot of them were killed in riots and such despite the authority and their attempts to fight people off who tried to kill them off.

Over the years, Tarone ended up being the one to rise to the highest fighting ranks, and while his mutation was a helping factor, it was clear that even without it he would have been pretty high up in the ranks. Especially due to the fact that when weapons were used and the mutation was mostly useless, he was still extremely talented.
