### SPELL COMPONENTS

*Any medium, in a format to be shared with the  
Coven Under the Blue Sky:*

- ✧ A bit of your witchcraft  
OR
- ✧ The craft of a witch you admire, with attribution
- ✧ The magic words: #BlueskyCoven #Expression

### ACTIVATION

One who is cursed is locked behind a barrier. Unfortunately, the barriers are often of their own making. Something vital inside them was closed off, which frequently opens the door to Other Things, things invested in keeping certain doors shut. The Accursed must remember who they are in order to break through those barriers.

Should a curse arise among members of the Coven, it is vital that we join together to aid in expressing that curse from the spiritual body before it spreads. The most potent remedy an individual witch may possess or perform in the relief of a powerful curse is an act of Self-expression.<sup>1</sup>

Sharing a True Craft that you made yourself,<sup>2</sup> that came from your mind, heart, and spirit, is not only an act of magical bravery but an encouragement to the Accursed to remember what they themselves think, feel, and love. It is an encouragement to act, to do, to express one's Self.

Even sharing something made by others can draw the curse out, so long as you connect that craft back to your Self. But the key to casting True Craft is that it is most effective when many of us contribute small acts of expression to lifting a curse. *Many drops of rain can together crumble cliffs.* In that sense, one need not worry about skill and execution, should they hinder spirit and communion.

*The best place to aim your True Craft is below where the curse has manifested. Together, may we surface it and cast it out.*
