(INFORMANT AND PW-1)

I am a resident of H3 Apartments, Korela. On 19 April 2021, The government of India in collaboration with the Datte Development Authority, announced the Datte Dam Development Project. My firm, Shriram Architects was hired on 20 June 2021 to oversee the construction of the same. We began our work on 20 June 2021 in accordance with the terms of our contract. Ms. Aashna and Ms. Triputi are residents of this area and since the very first day of construction they have been coming here under the guise of environmental conversion. They apparently run an organisation called 'Wildlife Nature Protection Conserve'.

On 17 August 2021, they sent me a handwritten letter stating that they would be taking prompt action against us. I was not sure as to what that meant, so I just kept the letter and nothing happened after some time.

I arrived at the construction site at 8:00am on 19 August 2021 like I usually do, both Aashna and Triputi were already there. I told them that stopping this project is not up to my discretion and they said, "Oh, so our letter had no effect? Wait till the end of the day you'll

realise what happens to people who disrespect the earth." I did not want to stay listening to that, so I left to go back to my cabin.

At 01:30 pm I saw them come back there in their vehicle, so I asked my employee Mr. Popey Tukde what the matter was when I heard the sound of a blast and I rushed to the site. There was a lot of smoke. Mr. Tukde had fallen down due to the impact. I saw Aashna and Triputi leaving but my priority was the safety of my employee so I called in the onsite paramedics who later took Tukde to the nearest hospital, where they said that he was unfortunately dead. I then called the police who arrived on the scene at 2:30 pm and examined the scene.

STATEMENT OF MR PRADEEP GULSHAN

(PW - 2)

I am a resident of Convention Centre Apartments, Korela. I am the security guard for the construction site and I was appointed by Shrishankar bhaiya. Usually the workers will come in by morning and start work, have lunch cooked on the site and work till late evening. Those two ladies would come regularly and make an unnecessary scene on the site. Work started from 20 June 2021 and I have been working since then. As far as I remember, on 19 August 2021, the two girls came back and gave some letter to sir.

Around 01:30 pm I saw them come back there in their vehicle, so I told shri shankar bhaiya who sent Popey sir to talk to them. We had just come back from cooking when we heard the sound of a blast and I rushed to the site. I rushed to see where I also saw those two girls leaving in a hurry, and unfortunately popey sir was hurt and after sending him to hospital, I heard that he died.

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Today, I the above-mentioned pancha, on being called by P.I. Bhondupujari Pujari, visited the Korela Police Station and subsequently, along with P.I. Bhondupujari Pujari, a PSI, and two constables, visited the place of occurrence of crime, at Datte Dam, Korela, at about 2.45p.m. in a Santro, under crime registration number 37 of 2021. The informant, Mr. Shrishankar Ram was personally present. I was requested to be panchas for conducting the said panchnama.

The informant showed us the place where the incident took place. We entered the Datte Dam complex after parking the car and were directed to take a left from the convention centre towards the mulshi road where we took a left turn and entered a plain road with construction going on the left . There were fragments of various objects such as a pressure cooker, blasting cap, and a black sort of strap with certain metallic powder remains, which were seized. We found that the construction site was severely damaged and the nearby

road also seemed to have been scraped off. We were informed that Shrishankar's employee, Mr. Topey who was sent to the hospital was pronounced dead.

We left the crime scene at 3.30 pm. The aforesaid panchnama is true and correct as per the site as seen by we panchas. Panchnama commenced at 2.45 pm and completed at 3:30 pm.

We followed the accused into the bedroom and instantly we were met with a familiar scent of powder, the officer then went on to open the cupboard and pulled out e-rickshaw batteries with some powder-like material on the same. The seized e-rickshaw batteries were placed in a transparent bag and were sealed with the label and the signatures of the police and myself. The rest of the house was searched but nothing else was found and we left the accused's house.

To see if there were any laws we could delve into to help save the biodiversity of the Datte area.

But because my mother was not well, I had to stay at home and could not join for the visit. So, I had called Aashna to tell her that I could not attend.

As far as I remember, on the day of 19th August 2021, we were visiting the construction site of the dam because we were working on a project related to construction services and laws around project development for our organization. To see if there were any laws we could delve into to help save the biodiversity of the Datte area.

When we were working around the area, we suddenly heard what seemed to be a loud blast, and seeing the fumes nearing us, we started to run and left in our scooters.

My scooter suffered some damage as the scorching heat from the flames had sparked it up and the scooter slipped. I was so baffled

They barged into my house, searched my rooms, and messed the house up looking for some sort of evidence apparently and in the end, they seized my electric scooter batteries which I told them were damaged due to the blast.

They left hurriedly and I was left astonished at the series of events that just took place. I don't understand why my sense of justice cannot be accepted. I cannot be arrested like this.

When we were working around the area, we suddenly heard what seemed to be a loud ear-ringing bomb blast, and seeing the fumes nearing us, we started to run and left in our scooters.

Aashna's scooter suffered some damage as the scorching heat from the flames had sparked it up and the scooter slipped. We parked the sort of damaged scooter at her place and waited for some time till the explosion and site cooled down so that we could visit

The simple bomb design implies that the maker was an amateur, incapable of acquiring more sophisticated materials. However, it could also have been the work of a sophisticated bomb maker taking great care to cover his tracks. Low explosives were used to make the bomb; the use does not appear to have been to kill anyone. it would have led to merely a blast through, hence the more squared off edges of the cooker remains.it can be triggered with something as simple as an egg timer or alarm clock. Traces of Sulphur were present No DNA/ evidence was recovered.
