Annual Membership Meeting July 20, 2025

President Jack Gangwish called the 2025 Annual Membership Meeting to order at 8:00 a.m. on Sunday, July 20, 2025, at the ISTA Home Grounds in Cedar Falls. Directors and alternates present include Ryan Meier, Gary DeBruin, Leland Kaufmann, Dennis Wonick, Tom McGehearty, Dick Wonick, and Ray Dentlinger. Others present include Secretary/Treasurer Lindsey Kaufmann, and 61 association members.

The minutes and financials were passed out when members entered the building for the meeting for viewing. Steve Glasgow moved to approve the 2024 Annual Meeting minutes, and Bill Nelson seconded it. Motion passed. John Dvorak and Stewart Hodge asked about the number of unpaid ISTA memberships for the current year when looking at the financials. Steve Hansen moved to approve the Treasurer's report, and Gary Dudley seconded it. Motion passed.

President Jack Gangwish introduced himself and the directors for each respective zone. Rod Goodrich was recognized for his efforts from 2019-2024 being the SW Zone Director, and John Dvorak was recognized for his efforts from 2022-2024 being the ISTA President.

Election of President:

Mike Dorland nominated Jack Gangwish, seconded by Steve Glasgow. Jack Gangwish was declared President.

Election of ATA Delegate:

Jim Cole nominated Steve Glasgow, and Dick Wonick seconded it. Steve Glasgow was declared ATA Delegate.

Election of ATA Alternate Delegate:

Bryan Stephens nominated Mick Friedel, seconded by Stewart Hodge. Mick Friedel was declared 1st ATA Alternate Delegate.

Nominations were called for 2nd ATA Alternate Delegate, but no one was nominated.

Old Business:

Jack Gangwish explained some of the new things the board has been working on or completed throughout this year:

- Sealed the road in the fall. Some of it on the east end still needs to be done, but the challenge is having 7 days of sit time as we never know until last minute when they will be able to apply the product.
- A new water meter was added to get more pressure for campers.
- 5 new walkways, a variety of speaker pads, and stem walks were added.
- A variety of shower house improvements were completed faucets, curtains, soap dispensers,
- Two new doors were installed on the Bob Allen building.
- A new fiber optic internet was installed, which has worked excellent for both shoots.
- John Mead donated the spray to apply for mosquitoes.
- The sound system is in the process of being re done.

Scholarship committee was formed and scholarships were awarded. Jack introduced Ray Dentlinger to discuss more the scholarship program. Lori Wickman was the chair. There was an application form for high school seniors and college freshman. College freshman were allowed to apply this last year, but will not in the coming years. There were 6 applicants, and 5 scholarships were given. The application was posted on the website, given access to SCTP coaches at the coaches' conference, and it was due on April 15th. There was a grading system in place with the names blacked out on the application when it was scored. It was suggested to put a poster or flyer to advertise in the gun club mailings, but it would need to be put out earlier.

New Business:

Lori Glasgow asked about getting more than one AED on the grounds. It is \$600 for an AET. We also need a stop the bleed kit on the west end and in the gun club building. Jack will work with Rick and Morgan to update Cedar Falls AED and get on located on the west end. Someone asked about needing to be qualified to us an AED, and Lori showed how easy it is to follow the instructions.

Alan Nicholas asked about having TVs rather than using phones to look up scores. Maybe TVs could be mounted on the scoreboard outside and use the one in the gun club.

Eric Jacobson asked about the Hall of Fame Committee. Jack responded that the board is still working on reaching out to people about filling the spots.

Raylee Bishop is working on Hall of Fame Biographies. She asked about if anyone was squad mates or friends of some of the individuals in the Hall of Fame that have passed to reach out to her. She is working with the Trap and Field to complete research on the shooter side. Qualifications for the Hall of Fame are posted on the ISTA website.

Jack Gangwish is in contact with Wapsie Pines about planting more trees with the possibility of watering the trees for us too.

Justin Venner complimented the board for how nice the grounds looked and thanked them.

There are 6 walkways left for new contract and a few stem walks too.

The 150th Iowa State Shoot and celebration will be in two years.

Bill Nelson asked about the conditions of the trap houses this week with all of the rain. There were 3 with water in them that have been pumped out every day. There was one with the corner broke off, but Ray Dentlinger formed it and fixed it before the shoot.

A motion to adjourn was made by Steve Glasgow and seconded by Bill Nelson. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 a.m.
