Resolution to Allocate Bird Scooter Partnership Funds to Judicial Branch Scholarships

WEDNESDAY, FEBRUARY 18, 2026

Whereas the Butler University Student Government Association (SGA) maintains a partnership with Bird Scooter Company that provides students with discounted, accessible, and sustainable transportation while generating annual funds for SGA; and

Whereas these funds are currently held in the general SGA account without a designated use, despite their potential to directly benefit Butler students; and

Whereas reallocating these funds to the Judicial Branch for student scholarships ensures that revenue generated by student transportation choices is reinvested directly into the student body; and let it be

Resolved that the Butler University Senate endorses the allocation of funds generated through the Bird Scooter partnership from the general SGA account to the Judicial Branch for the purpose of awarding student scholarships, let it be further

Resolved that SGA will promote this allocation as a collaborative effort between the Finance and Facilities Executive Board, Sustainability Executive Board, Judicial Branch, and Legislative Branch in support of student success and responsible resource use.
