

What should I be doing when I watch my instructional (learning) video?	
BEFORE the video.	<p>Make sure you have everything you need to be successful during the video.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Guided notes open. • Headphones on. • Have I ended peer conversations and focused on the video?
DURING the video	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take notes and fill in the blanks. • WATCH: To see what is being taught first. • REWIND To go back to take notes and fill in the blanks. • PAUSE: To take notes on the video.
AFTER the video	<p>Ask yourself, am I ready to practice what I have learned?</p> <p>→ Yes</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Continue your self paced learning to the practice problems. <p>→ No</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ REWATCH the video ◆ If you still do not understand after rewatching the video once: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ask a classmate who has mastered the lesson. 2. Use other learning resources. 3. Ask Mr. Pastore for one on one help or small group instruction.

Why is it important to watch **AND** take notes on the instructional (learning) video?

- Accountability: You are an important part of YOUR learning!
- To teach you your math content.
- To prepare you to reach mastery.

- Click the button to make the video take up the whole screen.
- Scroll down to make sure you do not miss any content.
- Watch the video, copy everything from the video that is not on your notes page.
- REMEMBER you can pause and rewind the video if you need to.
- Follow the video, take the notes, do the work and answer the guided questions correctly.
- Use your notes and the video to complete your assignments for the lesson.
- See if closed captioning is available on the video. Use it, it helps.

- **What if I don't get it!**

- Go over the video and your notes again.
- Did you give it your BEST effort? If you think you did, then you can ask a classmate who has already mastered this lesson for help. This is not social time, it is LEARNING time.
- Really try hard to understand the work on your own. It is challenging, but you can do it!

- **What if I STILL don't get it!**

- If this happens, you can follow the procedure for "What do I do if I need help?"
- Until then you should be working on should do's from previous lessons, practice problems from previous lessons or your iReady personalized path for math.

- **I TOTALLY get it! What's next?**

- Review the Mastery Check Rubric.
- If you are ready, then take the mastery check for the lesson. Once completed, you MOVE ON to the next lesson.
