# How can you ask a question?

Get Support: Faculty- During class

You can ask a question by speaking up during a class. Or raise your (digital) hand.

Get Support: Faculty- After a class

- Visit/Call me during office hours
- Scheduling an appointment. You can also schedule a meeting with the instructor outside of office hours.
- You can ask a question immediately after a class even if it is not your course/section.
- You can ask a question during any office hour available in the course outline.
  - In case of a deadline, try visiting in person or calling during an office hour.

### Midterm Makeup (Missed a midterm)

You can do makeup for personal health and immediate family emergencies.

1. Email an application explaining the situation.

- 2. "Show that you are serious" by doing all optional assignments, explain your assignment.
- 3. Find the makeup <u>fb</u> post and comment. Find a representative to keep the faculty updated and announce dates in class during attendance.
- 4. Submit a hardcopy of the application.
- 5. All students submit applications. All students who missed the midterm agree on a time (during an office or class time) and post on fb group. Also let me know 1 week in advance. (List of students, highlight dropped, non-communication)
- 6. Students appear for the makeup.
- 7. Students come on the last day of Grade Submission to review their grades.

### Midterm Makeup Scheduling

- 1. Find all the students across the course
  - a. From facebook group
  - b. Match with midterm grades posted for accounting all
- 2. Get a list of 3 time slots from me and get votes on fb to select a slot
- 3. Announce the slot.

# Get approval

- 1. "Show that you are serious"
- 2. Email an application explaining

- Assignments missed (Maximum 50%)
- Why missed with proof (e.g. Parent Signature)
- Request that you want an I
- 3. Get application approval during an office hour

# Complete the missing assignments

- 1. Follow the "Class Notes" document for assignment posting (you can also talk to the faculty during an office hour)
- 2. Email me the assignment. Notify me after you have completed all your missing assignments by email.
- 3. Received a grade at the end of the semester.

N.B. You should not register for the class (with NSU by paying money) again.
