We are ready to begin a new season of our expanded club dedicated to distance running. Our goals are to increase fitness and to find future athletes for 7th-12th grade cross country and track teams. The club is open to everyone who likes to run in grades 4/5/6. Key information:

- * Let's Run Club is sponsored by all 5 elementaries and all 3 middle schools in the Oak Hills district with the backing of principals and district admin.
- * The cost to join the club is \$10 which will pay for popsicles and Gatorade. You can pay at your first run---cash is fine or checks payable to Rapid Run MS (where I work).
- * We are a running club, but it's OK to walk. Running sessions will include a "Fun Run" and a short, low-key race at the end.
- * Parents are invited to attend and help out---there will be regular needs for stat keepers, etc. No experience required.
- * We'll run from late October through early December (first schedule below)---and resume in the spring. There's no requirement to attend any certain days---just come to the days that you can make it and no worries about the days that you can't.
- * If weather is an issue on a running day, check email for changes/cancellations. At this time of year, some days will be T-shirt and shorts weather while other days may require long sleeves, gloves, and a hat. You can always email me at the above address.
- * For those already in a school running club or OHYA track or GOTR, please consider joining Let's Run in addition to your other group---we want Let's Run to coexist with similar clubs.

- * Running schedule for the first 2 weeks (you'll get a new schedule every week after):
Wed. Oct. 30---500pm to 540pm at Fernbank Park Lodge.
Thurs. Nov. 7---500pm to 540pm at Oakdale Elem.

Welcome Back! Here is the **HOME athletic ticket information** for OHHS, BMS, DMS, and RRMS athletic events for **2024-25!**

All of our OH All-Sports Pass and individual game ticket options are listed for our fans on the oakhillssports.com website. We highly encourage students, parents, grandparents, family members, and all fans to purchase an OH All-Sports Pass for the 2024-25 school year as the OH All-Sports Pass gets you entry into all HOME Oak Hills High School, Bridgetown Middle School, Delhi Middle School, and Rapid Run Middle School athletic team events except tournaments for the entire school year. You will be sent 1 QR code for the school year and the processing fees are included in the pass prices.

Tickets can also be purchased with CASH or CREDIT CARD at the ticket gate. Tickets purchased online or at the ticket gate with a CREDIT CARD will be charged a processing fee.

For OHLSD Residents 65+ we also have the free Highlander Golden Card which works like an OH All-Sports Pass! Register and receive a card at OHHS in the Athletic Office or call Jen Armbruster at District Office at 513-574-3200 to set up an appointment!

****OHLSD Staff IDs may be used for entry into all HOME OHLSD school team athletic events except tournaments, however, you MUST show the ID at the ticket gate! Only the staff member will receive free entry.**
