



Summary of Interventions Cycling4Gaza2025

Ajyal will continue to offer support for displaced children in Gaza. As part of the support from C4G, Ajyal will be offering the support listed below*:

*As the situation is volatile and rapidly changing, please be mindful that we might need to adjust or change interventions for Gaza based on emerging priorities

1. Immediate support

To continue to address volatile conditions in Gaza and rapidly changing circumstances and needs of displaced children, Ajyal will continue offering ongoing Emergency Support Interventions for displaced children and their families to address emerging immediate needs. These will be planned and delivered in consultation with our team on the ground and will be based on continuous and rapid assessment of emerging needs of displaced children, availability of resources and materials in Gaza, and risks associated with procurement and delivery of support/services.

2. Short term support

Ajyal will offer support in areas of education and mental welfare, including expanding its education support to thousands more children through its current ***Community-Led Educational Initiatives***.

Ajyal will support the education of displaced children throughout Gaza through these already established community-led educational initiatives. These initiatives offer spaces organised and led by qualified teachers to facilitate education of displaced children within or around the vicinity of their respective displacement areas. Education provided in the community-led-initiatives will be focusing on lost learning and on rebuilding foundational skills in three subject areas (Arabic, Maths and English), and on rebuilding a sense of community and purpose amongst school-aged children.

Ajyal will be prioritising areas that have received limited or no support during the ongoing genocide (e.g., North Gaza), and other areas that are currently overcrowded due to ongoing displacement orders (e.g., Khan Younis).

Ajyal's efforts will be directed towards supporting as many teacher-led initiatives as possible, and aim to help them offer continuous and meaningfully directed learning to as many children as possible. Ajyal's sponsorship of the selected initiatives will offer teachers financial reimbursement, educational materials and necessary basic stationary; as well as psychosocial kits.

Wherever possible, Ajyal will expand its support to establish toilets to support safe access to toilets for children, especially girls. Ajyal will work to provide water tanks and washing stations to support hydration and hygiene of children.

3. Long term support

Ajyal is developing interventions offering survivors of the genocide with Gaza-context-rooted, trauma-informed and sensitive support in areas of education and mental health. This support will be offered in different forms and mediums including resources (online and print), training and local support services in mental health and education across Gaza.

This localisation of knowledge and expertise aligns with Ajyal's and C4G's mission and values of ensuring Palestinians' agency and dignity is preserved, while also ensuring the sustainability of necessary education and mental health provisions now and into the future.
