

Finally, copper cupolas are designed to not only let moist air out, but they allow natural sunlight to come in, illuminating the attic or top floor of your home. Not only is having an old-fashioned spin on a skylight cozy and quaint, it also will save you money on your electric bill.

You can even peak through the slits and spy your neighborhood from on high. Here in New Orleans and Jefferson Parish, many homes by Lake Pontchartrain are topped with cupolas where residents can look over the levee and out at the water below.

Cupolas are usually used to admit air and light into the top floor or attic of a home or building. Sometimes, as we just discussed, they are used as lookout points over a neighborhood or a body of water. They are usually set atop a larger dome or roof, and visually appear almost like a crown.


They have been around for centuries, and trace their origin back to the Roman Empire. As a matter of fact, the word "copula" translates to "little cup" in Italian, and it derives from Latin. However, while they may seem quite small compared to the roofs that they top, they usually average between five and eight feet tall.

However, as time has gone on, while they are no longer a necessity for residential buildings in warmer climates as they once were, cupolas have made an astonishing comeback as a home decoration.
