***The Snowflake Man* by PuppetKabob**

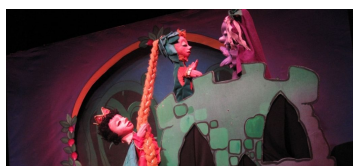

- Field trips can take place between 9:30am and 11:30am on the days listed in this document. You choose what time works best for you when booking!
- Field trip tickets are \$14 per person including children and adults. Ask about our Mary Churchill Memorial Fund for subsidized tickets.
- We have a \$600 minimum to run a field trip. If you are a small group, ask in your inquiry form about dates when another group is already attending, or try to coordinate bringing multiple classes to the same show.
- All field trips take place in our 100 seat theater at 32 Station St. Brookline, MA 02445. We have a step free entrance, an accessible bathroom, and accessible seating. Please let us know if you have any specific access needs, we are happy to make accommodations.
- We do not have a lunch room on-site but we can recommend places nearby.
- Bus drop-off takes place at our front door. We do not have dedicated bus parking, but bus drivers have no problem finding a spot to wait on our street.
