Please be prepared to show your ID and provide information regarding a guest when purchasing tickets. **If your guest is from outside the district, you must complete a guest permission form by Thursday, April 16, before tickets can be purchased.** Guests must be at least a freshman in high school and no older than 20 years old, and all students and guests must show an ID upon entering prom. Formal attire is required.
