Selection procedures shall consist of the following steps:

- 1) *Eligibility for candidacy: Must be a graduating senior from Warren County Career Center, this includes all **Partner Schools**.*
- 2) *The recipient must have clear goals and passions for furthering their trade, through a four or two-year college, vocational-technical school, an apprenticeship program, or structured plan for an entrepreneur's self-employment.*
- 3) *Must have the minimal GPA of 2.75*
- 4) *Return the completed application one sided and on time. Failure to meet the due date will result in elimination.*
- 5) *Include your 7th semester transcript with WGPA and NGPA*
- 6) *Include two reference letters. May only use one teacher as a recommender. Employer in your trade field is recommended. Family members may not be allowed as a reference.*
- 7) *The selection committee will select recipient(s) by majority vote. The committee has the final vote.*
- 8) *The scholarship recipient and his/her parent(s)/guardian(s) will be invited to join members of Miami Chapter for a dinner in their honor at the Waynesville Masonic Temple in **June**, where the scholarship money will be presented.*
