

Year 1 Planner – Dynamo Dinosaurs

Topic (History and Geography)

Children will learn about where in the world dinosaur bones have been discovered and where these continents are on a world map, whilst learning about Mary Anning's important discoveries. We will also be looking at when dinosaurs lived and the different types of dinosaurs that roamed the Earth.

English

For the first term, the children will focus on learning their phonic sounds. They will build confidence sounding out, blending and improving fluency when reading. When writing, children will learn to apply their phonic sounds in order to support their spelling. We will begin with the introductory texts of 'The Colour Monster' and 'Perfectly Norman', before moving on to 'Harry and His Bucket Full of Dinosaurs'. With these texts, the children will learn about adjectives and verbs to use in both descriptive and instructional writing.

Czech

V prvním školním termu budou děti rozvíjet správnou výslovnost a plynulost řeči při vypravování, přednášení či běžné každodenní konverzaci. Budou uvolňovat ruku pomocí grafomotorických cvičení. Seznámí se s českými samohláskami. Dozví se o přechodech mezi ročními obdobími, změnách v přírodě, tradicích a zvycích patřících do podzimu. V předmatematických dovednostech se zaměří číslíce do 10, počítání v řadě a základní orientaci v časových údajích (dny v týdnu).

Mathematics

In Mathematics, we will be working on place value for a number of weeks, working on counting, representing numbers, one more and one less etc. This will be done using a range of Mathematical resources such as counters, tens frames, number lines, number beads, base 10 and Multilink. After place value, we will then move on to addition and subtraction within 10.

Science

During science, children will label body parts and find out about their bodies using the Funnybones story as a stimulus. They will also learn about which parts of the body have the five senses.

Physical Education

Initially lessons will focus on student's communication and teamwork skills. Children will develop their ability to be Ready, Respectful and Safe through fun, varied physical games and activities that develop important gross motor skills and equipment control, along with their understanding around Park Lane's five R's, Respectful, Responsible, Resourceful, Resilient and Risk Taking.

Computing

In the first half of the term the pupils will focus on improving their keyboard skills and we will learn about how to stay safe online.

Music

Year 1 will be learning all about Hip Hop music. We will be listening and appraising different songs within the Hip Hop style. We will be using our key song 'Hey You!' to improve our singing, improvising and performing skills.

Art

Children will be learning: - To make observational drawings using a variety of media, such as oil and soft pastels, pencils. - To design, build and test their own rocket, - To follow instructions to create a range of pictures around the theme Forests.

PSHE (Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education)

Children will be learning about what makes them special. They will learn to identify what similarities and differences there are between them and others, remembering to celebrate our differences. We will also explore emotions, focussing on what it looks and feels like and look at strategies to help us with a variety of emotions.

Project Learning

Children will be involved to design and make a story sack based around the inspiring book The Gruffalo by Julia Donaldson.
