

Spooner Rodeo Parade FAQ's

SPECTATORS:

--Where do spectators watch the parade?

The Spooner Rodeo page has a map detailing the parade's route. You can set up your chair on either side of the street along that route.

--Can you put out chairs early for the parade?

Spectators can put out chairs early at their own risk. There is no security along the parade route to make sure items remain in their place.

--Where can I park?

Parking is available in the Spooner Municipal Lots located near the downtown area on Walnut Street as well as along the side streets along the parade route.

--How long does the parade last?

The parade can last anywhere between 45 minutes to an hour pending the amount of parade units entered into the parade.

--Is there a concession area?

No, there is no concession area designated during the parade. However, there are groups that will walk the parade route selling bottled water, soda, etc.

--What time does the parade start?

The parade always starts at Noon on Saturday of rodeo weekend. Should there be any changes to the start time of the parade, those messages will be communicated via Heart of the North Spooner Rodeo Facebook page.

--What if there is bad weather?

In the case of "bad weather", the Spooner Rodeo Chairman and Parade Coordinator(s) will make a

decision on parade postponement or cancellation by 10:30AM and put out communication accordingly thereafter.

PARADE PARTICIPANTS:

--How do I sign up to participate in the parade?

Registration for the Rodeo Parade is all done online. The link to registration can be found on [SpoonRodeo.com/rodeo-parade](http://SpoonerRodeo.com/rodeo-parade)

--Where do we line up for the parade?

Staging information, including directions, will be emailed to all registered participants during the week of the parade. In general, staging will be at the north end of town.

--What time should we start lining up?

Parade units may begin arriving at the staging area(s) starting at 10:00AM and arriving no later than 11:30AM

--How do we get our number for the parade lineup?

Assignments for the parade are provided in an email about 24 hours prior to the start of the parade.
