

Each week I manually scan the codex recording changes and new discoveries. The oddity that is about to be described has existed in the codex since I started recording in Jan 24, 3307. It has always remained the same, until recently.


There is an odd thing in the Pilot Federations codex, where it appears that the codex isn't capable of adding, a clear sign of a coverup. You can validate this yourself with checking your codex and a calculator.

As an example, if you go into the codex discoveries section and select the Emyrean Straits, you will be shown what has been discovered in that region by all commanders, and what your own personal discoveries are (well it would if you were in that region, but that isn't today's issue).



In the Empyrean Straits, there have been 450 biological and geological discoveries by commanders.

Drilling down into the Biological and Geological section, it is broken down into two groups, Geology and Anomalies, and Organic Structures.




If we add up those numbers, they don't equate to the number displayed on the region counts.

Not all regions have this issue, most match but the following have had discrepancies ever since I started recording the codex entries in Jan 24, 3307

Given that the discoveries of years gone by may have been difficult to validate, I simply noted in the margins of my document, and haven't given it too much thought.

But today..... April 2, 3308 I have recorded an off by count increase from 3 to 4 in Inner Orion Spur!

That means that somewhere between March 26, 3308 and April 2, 3308 something has changed, but the Pilots Federation appear to be hiding what that discovery was!

Was it a new anomalie? Perhaps a new man eating Brain Tree variant?
Or was it something so threatening that they had to redact it, but botched the coverup.


All I have is a timeframe window and a count increase. I will continue to monitor the Pilots Federation each week, and report any other discrepancies.

UPDATE April 9th 3308

In the last week, something has also now changed in the Sanguineous Rim region. It has gone from a completely valid set of codex entries that match, to now being off by 1.

The primary codex page says 474 Biological and Geological Signals, but if you add up the inner codex discoveries they only come to 473.

In two weeks, two new discrepancies in two close regions to the bubble. Both regions are known for thargoid activity, could the pilot's federation be hiding some new discovery about the Thargoids? CMDR MATTHEWDREAD this week did discover Solid Mineral Spheres, Prasinum Metallic Crystals, and Flavum Metallic Crystals which were previously not seen within the Sanguineous Rim region. Perhaps there is a dire anomaly that just can't be released to the public?


Two discrepancies within such a short timeframe, makes me feel like something is afoot.

UPDATE April 23rd 3308

This week, Odin's discrepancy went from 2 to 3. Unknown if it is related, but CMDR BARBA NEGRA 82 found a Viride Lagrange Storm Cloud in the region, the first to be found there.

The Trojan's Belt region went from 0 to 2. Another region, and not just a single increase but a double increase!

UPDATE May 7th 3308

Something I haven't yet seen in the codex came up today. In the Sanguineous Rim region, the Xeno count in the codex changed from 6 to 7 this week. However when you drill into the codex, there are only the 6 old entries. This is the first time I have discovered a count mismatch within the Xeno section, and the first time I have seen the Xeno count change since I started recording the codex. You can check this yourself in your own codex


Is something big coming? What is the Pilot's Federation hiding?

Quick addition, The number in Sanguineous Rim increased to 8 shortly after writing this update, meaning that it changed within a few hours.... So something was discovered between 15:00 and 18:00 in game time.

UPDATE June 8, 3308

Hawking's gap has gone from not having an issue to having a Bio/Geo discrepancy of 1. Temple has gone from not having an issue to having a Bio/Geo discrepancy of 2..




UPDATE December 3, 3308

The Inner Orion Spur region xeno count is now off by 1.

This week the Thargoids attacked the bubble, and within the Maelstrom systems, you can scan "Thargoid Caustic Generator" which appears like a codex entry, but it doesn't appear in the codex. Is this one of the items that causes the same discrepancy in Sanguineous Rim? Is there a second item to scan in the Thargoid fleet yet?


UPDATE December 3, 3308

The Inner Orion Spur region xeno count is no longer off. Two new thargoid entries were added this week, and one of them must have been the entry causing the discrepancy.

- Thargoid Interceptor Orthrus in EBISU found by CMDR MSTHEO
- Thargoid Caustic Generator in HYADES SECTOR FB-N B7-6 found by CMDR LEGENDARYHOBO

The Xeno entries in Sanguineous Rim still show a discrepancy, so whatever changes the Pilot's federation made appear to only have applied to the Inner Orion spur, or that it requires a new scan to properly record the entry.
