

# **Educator Grant Checklist, Application, and Guidelines**

**Deadlines** for Grant Submission (online): Fall Semester: November 3, 2025 by 4:30 PM Spring Semester: April 1, 2026 by 4:30 PM

### Checklist for grant application submission (in this order):

- 1. Grant Budget Spreadsheet
- 2. Educator Grant Application
- 3. <u>Signature Form</u> (signature from Principal and every teacher and / or administrator whose name is included as a grant writer is required)
- 4. <u>Technology Request Form</u> (if necessary)
- 5. Facilities Request Approval please email August Wunderlich for approval (if necessary)

### **Grant Types and Amounts:**

- Individual Teacher Grants (\$5,000 maximum) for projects that support classroom instruction.
- Campus Teams (2 or more teachers) / Department Site Grants (\$7,500 maximum) for campus teams or department projects.
- Multi-Campus Grants (\$15,000 maximum) for projects of two or more schools.
- "Lead the Spark" Grants (up to \$25,000 maximum), open to campus principals for new programs / projects at their campuses.

#### **Grant Criteria:**

Each grant application should include specific grant criteria that guide evaluation by the Foundation's Grant Review Committee.

Generally grants should:

- Be innovative initiatives that support the mission of the district.
- Support specific classroom, department, campus or school needs.
- Impact the quality of education for students.
- Relate to goals stated in the campus / district plan of action.
- Ability to replicate is important and will be a factor considered.

#### **Grant Selection Process:**

The Grant Review Committee, comprised of the following members, will review the applications:

- 1) Initial review and evaluation will be conducted by the Klein ISD Education Foundation (KEF) Grants Committee. Evaluation and review will be based on the rubric.
- 2) Executive Directors for Teaching and Learning or designee will review and evaluate based on the rubric.
- 3) The KEF Grants Committee will make final decisions on recommendations for funding and present slate to the KEF Board of Directors.
- 4) KEF Board of Directors approves final slate of grants.
- 5) If approved, the grants will then be presented to the Klein ISD Board of Trustees for formal acceptance.

The Grant Committee will make one of the following recommendations for each application: A) approval, B) approval with conditions and / or modifications, including partial funding, or C) non-approval.

### **Grant Application Guidelines:**

Individual teacher grants belong to a campus unless the principal approves a transfer to another campus. Site grants are non-transferable.

### Things to Avoid:

- 1. Generally, funds will not be awarded for:
  - a. Salaries and fees for speakers
  - b. Snacks or refreshments
  - c. Awards and trophies
  - d. T-shirts
  - e. Airfare, hotel, food, transportation or other travel expenses
- 2. Funds will not be awarded for multiple applications from an individual school to fund an entire program.

## **Preparation Guidelines:**

- 1. Please provide an explanation for all acronyms.
- Make sure you have met the technology and / or facility approval requirements, if applicable, and <u>have the approval uploaded</u> to your application. Please email Chief of Operations, August Wunderlich (<u>awunderlich@kleinisd.net</u>) for approval of building / campus modifications.
- 3. Check to see that you have included all required signatures and / or approval forms.

### **Budget Guidelines:**

- 1. Make sure to include additional costs for shipping or a written statement for free shipping.
- 2. When obtaining a written quote from a vendor, explain that grant funds will not be available until the following semester.
- 3. Follow Klein ISD purchasing guidelines, including use of approved Klein ISD vendors.
- 4. No state sales tax.
- 5. Round off to even numbers. For example, if your budget is \$2,868.44, round up to \$2,900.
- 6. Consult with your school's financial secretary before the budget is submitted.
