### **Holdings and Circulation**

Our circulation for June 2025 was 913 items, plus 50 honor books and 20 puzzles for a total of 983. The circulation for June 2024 was 953, so there was a increase of 30 in circulation. Through Libby, there were 325 checkouts.

## **Library Wireless**

According to the report generated by our router, in June, there were 177 unique clients, with an average of 16 clients per day. On June 30th, there was an above average usage for a Monday. The bandwidth usage was 1350% higher than the last ten Monday s recorded.

### **Inter-Library Loan**

In June, we received 87 books and other items to fill requests made by our patrons. And we sent 208 items to other libraries for their patrons.

#### **New Patrons**

Last month we registered 13 new patrons.

### **Collection Development**

Last month we added 57 adult books (including the books for Roger Summerhayes' collection, 19 young adult books, 31 children's books, 4 DVDs, and 17 magazines. We discarded 2 adult books, 16 DVDs, and 32 magazines.
