

How to register for Math Kangaroo Competition

- not earlier than September 15

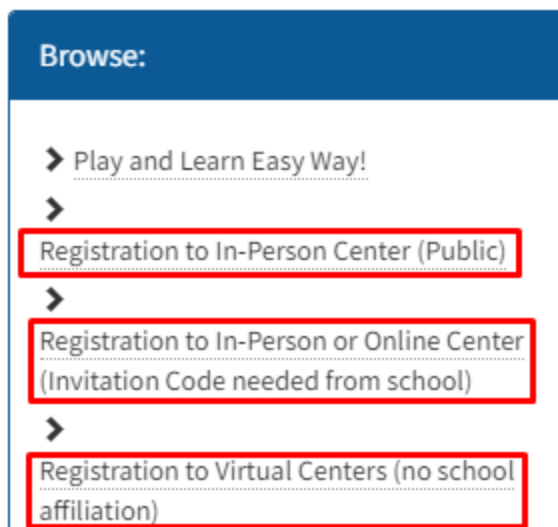
Before you register or before you see the center you want to register at you **MUST** log in to your account [HERE](#) first.

** If you are a MK faculty, make sure you are in the Learner's mode. Click on your name in the upper right corner and then click on: Switch to Learner.*

Once you are logged in under the blue section called Browse, on the left-hand side you will see three center options to register at:

- **In-person Center (Public)**
- **In-Person or Online Center (Invitation Code needed from school)**
- **Virtual Center** (unproctored center)

Choose one of the above options to register.

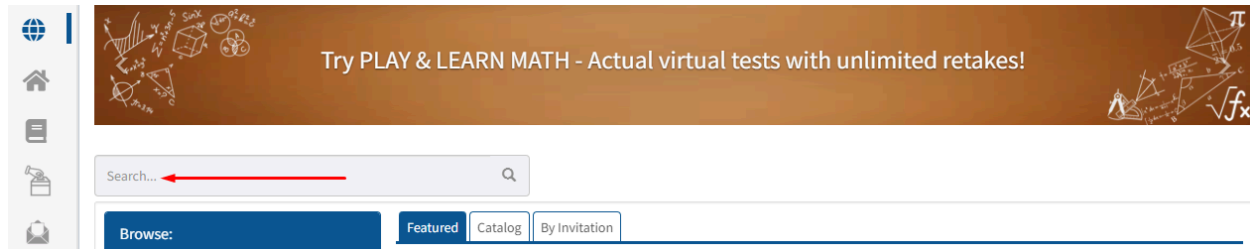
Note:

- The following two centers: **In-person Center (Public)** and **Virtual Center** will let you register without restrictions or codes
- This center: **In-Person or Online Center (Invitation Code needed from school)** will require a code that you can only receive from a Math Kangaroo manager that represents a school that participates in the competition.

Another way to register to **In-person Center (Public)** and **Virtual Center** (no school affiliation) is by looking up the center in the search field:

1. Log in to your account [HERE](#) first.
2. Type the center name you would like to register at in the search field: **In-person Center (Public)** or **Virtual Center** (no school affiliation).

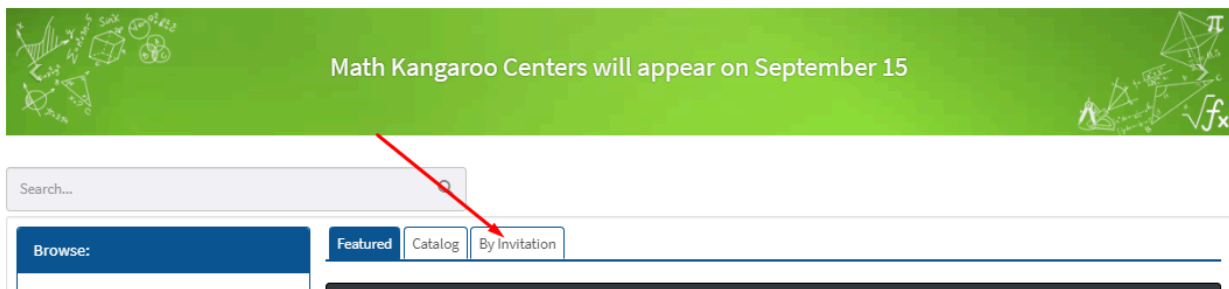


Once your center is generated, click on the link with this center's name.

Another way to register to **In-Person or Online Center (Invitation Code needed from school)** is by looking up the center through the **By Invitation** tab:

1. Log in to your account [HERE](#) first.
2. Click on the **By Invitation** tab
3. Type the invitation code you received from your Math Kangaroo manager (e.g., your teacher or other school official)
