

Freelance Landscape Quilt Supply list

1. Fabric: 2 fat quarter for the sky (one fat quarter will be used to back the quilt).
1 fat quarter for the tree.
1 fat quarter for the leaves (if you want to mix your fabrics for the leaves, you can get several different fabrics).

Batik fabrics are strongly suggested.

2. Low loft batting. (The size of a fat quarter).
3. **Sharp** sewing scissors (A large [8"] and a small [4"-5"] set of scissors)
4. Elmer glue stick (the kind you would get for an elementary school student)



5. Oil pastel crayons (I use Pentel brand)



6. Black, Brown and Grey or Silver permanent markers (make sure they are permanent. You might be ironing with steam) I recommend Sharpie markers, but any permanent mark should work.
7. Sewing machine and several colors of thread to match the tree fabric and the leaves. (earth tones...light brown, dark brown, grey, black, etc.)...I like to use invisible thread (especially metallic invisible thread) for part of the quilt. Both Aurifil and Gutermann make invisible thread.
8. Small piece of low loft batting. (The size of a fat quarter).
