

Getting Started with the “Canvas Student” App

There are **five** main things students need to know to use the mobile app to access [Canvas, the York Online study space](#):

1. How do I get the App?

The “Canvas Student” app is available in app stores on iOS and Android mobile devices:



2. How do I log in and get started?

Logging in:

- Log in guides: [Android log in tips](#) / [iOS log in tips](#).
- Enter **University of York** (not “York University”, that’s in Canada!) into the **What’s your school’s name** field.
- Login using your short username (eg. abc123) and the **password** that you use for your University email.

Getting started:

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3. What **does** work well in the Canvas app?

1. Quickly checking Course (Module) **content**: [Android content tips](#) / [iOS content tips](#).
 2. Checking **Announcements** that have been added by staff: [Android announcement tips](#) / [iOS announcement tips](#).
 3. Reading and responding to **Discussions**: [Android discussion tips](#) / [iOS discussion tips](#).
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4. What **doesn’t** work well in the Canvas app?

1. **Assessments** - Checking due dates, assignment details or grades/feedback, taking tests or submitting assignments. **We strongly advise against using the Canvas app for any form of assessment activity.**
 - a. To learn more about why you shouldn’t use mobile apps for assessment activity please read [E-Assessment and the Canvas app](#).
 2. **Reading Lists** - Access these via Chrome or Firefox web browser instead.
 3. **Videos in the iOS and Android Canvas app** - Unfortunately videos do not display in the Canvas app. Instead, use:
 - a. A web browser when accessing videos on a mobile device (preferably Google Chrome), and use the relevant following guide if the videos don’t work via your mobile web browser:
 - i. [Help: Viewing videos view browser on an Android device](#)
 - ii. [Help: Viewing videos on an iPhone or iPad](#)
 - b. Or instead [use the Panopto app](#).**IMPORTANT:** [select the option “York Canvas \(York Online\)” when logging in to the video platform](#).
 - c. [Kanopy video content can also need special consideration and action on mobile](#).
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4. **ePortfolios** - There is no direct link to ePortfolios in Canvas via the app. We recommend accessing your ePortfolio via a web browser on a PC or Mac instead.
 5. **Opening some PDFs** - Certain PDFs don't seem to open via the Canvas app. If this happens to you, we would suggest trying your mobile browser instead.
 6. **Calendars** - Ensure that your module has been [added as a favourite](#) in the dashboard for the calendar to be visible via the app.
