## Results of our 6G Framework [6G Assessment](#)

- Overall growth from 69.6% one year ago, to 78.3% now
- Improved in Support Systems from 62% last year to 82.2% now
- Membership area increased from 66.2% to 75%
- Engagement area increased from 73% to 76%
- Recognition area increased from 71% to 81%
- Capital area increased 65% to 79%

## General Ideas from discussion:
