

Scrum Meeting #2

There are 3 questions in the daily Scrum meeting:

1. What did I accomplish yesterday?

Josh: I was able to begin progress on the restaurant list and menu items list functionality, but some issues need to be fixed.

Aiet: fixed issue of the list of restaurants not showing on the app. Began to work on “view cart” function

Godday: I began setting up the search feature

Michael: Worked on populating lists with restaurants and their menus from Amplify AppSync

2. What will I do today?

Josh: I will continue to work on the restaurant and menu items functionality so the proper items are displayed when a restaurant is clicked on.

Aiet: begin working on the “view cart” application on app. So i will create the view and be able to add a menu item to the list.

Godday: I will finish implementing the search feature

Michael: Complete authentication flow using Android Navigation and touch up home layout XML files

3. What obstacles are impeding my progress?

Josh: Right now, the wrong view is being shown when a restaurant is clicked on so I need to figure out that issue.

Aiet: the only thing which will make the view cart aspect be fully functional is when josh completes his part of the user story.

Godday: I need to figure out the proper way to use the search widget and how to interact with the database.

Michael: Figuring out how to get menu items to populate list after clicking restaurant

For the project we will have the 3 following questions:

1. What did I accomplish since the last Scrum?

Josh: I added restaurants and their menu item data values into our team’s Amplify database. I also began the coding that allows a restaurant’s menu items to pop up when a restaurant is clicked.

Aiet: created the page for which will lead you to the view cart tab

Godday: I added a SearchView element to the home screen and began writing the Java code for it.

Michael: Implemented generic recyclerview adapter, viewmodel, and abstract fragment to extend for any recycler list in app

2. What will I do until the next Scrum?

Josh: I will continue to work on the restaurant and menu item functionality as well as the demo and retro for class.

Aiet: I will continue to work on the view cart tab

Godday: I will continue to work on the Java code for the SearchView

Michael: Work on sending arguments between fragments in Navigation component and complete checkout screen with Stripe

3. What obstacles are impeding my progress?

Josh: Time constraint and confusion using git and android studio.

Aiet: timing is certainly the biggest factor when completing the work.

Godday: I need to learn how to search through our list of restaurants using SearchView.

Michael: Figuring out how to properly implement Amplify GraphQL database to fit our ideas, as well as timing
