Field Report: Fields need repainted, have 5 gallons of paint. Would like to get them painted before the next home games. Going to need another 10 gallons of paint. Cheapest price found at Home Depot for \$20-30 per 5 gallon can. New nets were placed on the new U10 goals. Wanting to have fencing behind the goals along the railroad track line and along the U8 field in a L shape. Suggestion to temporarily use orange construction fencing at this time with school approval. Maybe a long term solution would be to see if a Boy Scout or someone would be interested in a community service (Eagle Scout) project. Rough pricing at about \$200 for the orange fence and posts. U12 nets will need replaced before next season, and possibly one U10 net needs replaced. Made dollies so that the goals can be moved by one person. Storage shed- still need to talk to the district about ability to place at 1111 Faircrest location. Flags may need to be replaced before next season, they are approximately \$100 for 4 flags. Gina Miller motion to approve expenditures (\$400) for fencing and 10 gallons of paint. Jenni Waidman second. All in favor. None opposed.
