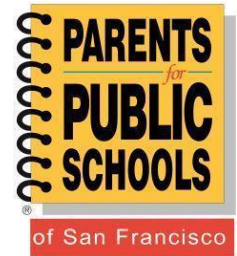

**Time Commitment:** Approximately 10 hours per week, including board meetings, committee meetings, and direct service/operational activities. This is a stipend role which pays twice a month.

### Role Overview:

Parents for Public School SF (PPS-SF) is seeking teammates who are passionate about public schools and dedicated to promoting public school value to our communities. As a PPS Ambassador Coach, you will play a vital role in both strategic and operational goals of the organization. Strategically you will be responsible for uplifting the mission and vision of our organization and its 26-year-old impact. By actively contributing to its day-to-day operations, you will work alongside the community and its schools to ensure active engagement with public schools. All PPS Ambassador Coaches are responsible for providing strategic leadership, ensuring operational sustainability, and advancing our mission through hands-on involvement.

### Responsibilities:

- **Pre-school:**
  - Contact new preschools by phone to introduce the work of PPS and offer to provide an enrollment presentation. Follow up with emails/ mailing of materials.
  - Attend some of the community engagement events on behalf of PPS.
  - Support enrollment workshops.
  - Facilitate quarterly stories from parents about public school's experiences.
- **TK-12 Schools:**

With the support from the President,

  - Meet with School Principals for Parent Ambassador Recruitment
  - Facilitate workshops about shared governance and active family partnership for schools
  - Facilitate workshops to strengthen social media presence for selected schools.
  - Facilitate quarterly stories from parents about public school's experiences.

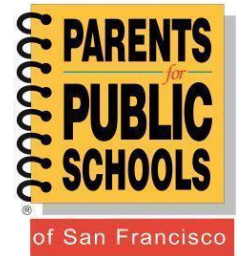
