Bridge Building Script

Objective of the Canvass: During this canvass you will be talking to our Bridge Building universe which tends to break down to two groups of people:

- Persuadable needs ID (i.e. people that relatively frequently vote but we are have little data on them and do not know who they are likely to support)
- Persuade to Participate (people who share our values but are less motivated to vote i.e. missed 2024 or 2022 elections).

Your goal of this canvass is to actively listen to the voter, start to build a relationship and get IDs for Democrats. You will be successful walking away from the conversation if the voter feels listened to and you have gotten an ID (so we know if/when to follow up with that voter). These might be difficult conversations but identifying even ONE person that we can follow up with next year could be vital to our path to victory (Wisconsin frequently comes down to ~3 votes per ward).
