

If students do not receive a lock on the 27th or at Transition To Middle School, then they will receive their locks during 1st hour on the September 2nd..

Returning 7th and 8th graders: Returning 7th and 8th grade students are reminded to bring their school issued combination lock back to school on August 27th to secure their items in their lockers OR bring their locks back to school on September 2nd.

New 7th and 8th Graders: Students new to Whitnall entering 7th or 8th grade should get their school issued combination lock from our WMS office.

2025-26 Student Schedules

The 2025 - 26 student schedules, teacher assignments, locker assignments & transportation will be published in the Infinite Campus Parent and Student Portals on August 18th after 4pm.

Flight class schedules are still being worked on and subject to change. So if your student's schedule is missing their Flight class please do not be alarmed as it will be assigned and present on their schedule in Infinite Campus prior to the start of school.

For 7th and 8th grade students, we do our best to honor their requested elective courses they communicated to us during the 24-25 school year; however, due to the elective combinations they may have chosen given our A day / B day schedule for electives we can not guarantee they get ALL of their

choices. Other factors include class size limits and the number of sections we are running for that specific elective course(s).

What is the "Flight" Period in my Child's Schedule?

For 6th grade families and those new to Whitnall, the following is a brief explanation of Flight. Our WMS Flight period is taught by core teachers (math, science, social studies, English Language Arts [ELA]). Some aspects of the Flight Period are as follows:

- It will group students in a homeroom
- It will allow time for students to complete homework or to meet with teachers for additional assistance with coursework
- It will be the time for select students to receive either ELA or math intervention and support
- It will be the time for learning about things such as academic and career planning or PBIS (Positive Behavior Interventions & Supports)

In addition to being a time to receive support or complete classwork, Flight is also a time to receive enrichment. There are mini units that extend learning in the core content areas. For example, there will be a mini unit on Wisconsin forests as an extension of science. All mini units align with district learning targets and standards.




